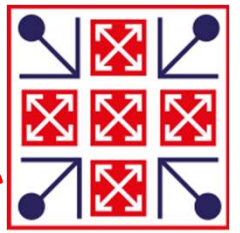


- White shirt (short or long sleeved) with the school tie

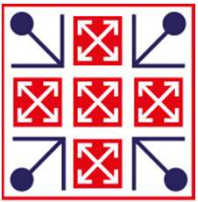

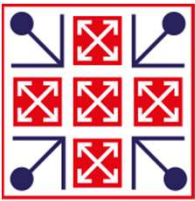

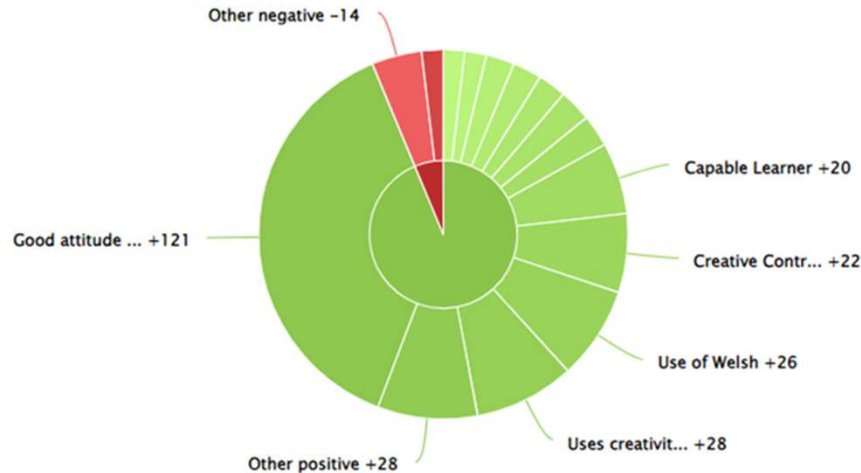


# Class Charts- CLR

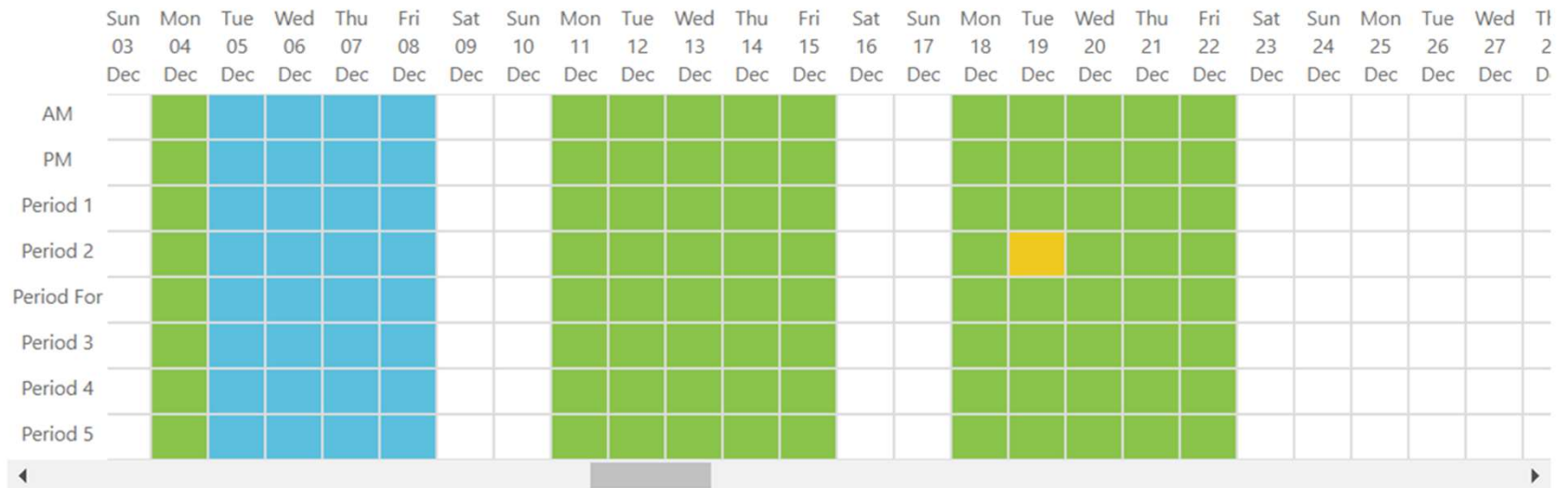
Parents should use class charts to:

- You'll be emailed your access code early September.

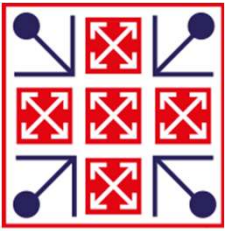
Behaviour score breakdown



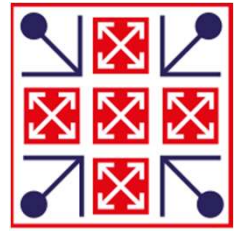

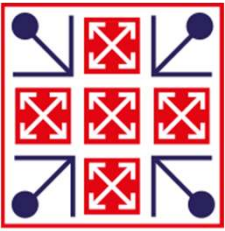


# Beth sydd angen? / What to bring-RJ

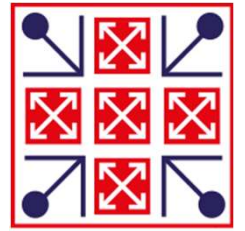


- Pencil case – black or blue pens, pencils, ruler, sharpener, rubber, highlighter, green pen.

- A water bottle – there are fountains around the school to refill throughout the day.

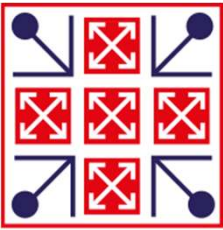




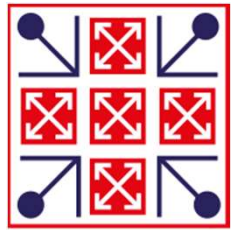
# Diwrnod gyntaf / First Day in September- RJ

- There will only be a few year groups in school on Y7’s first day to give them the opportunity to find their way around without all year groups in.



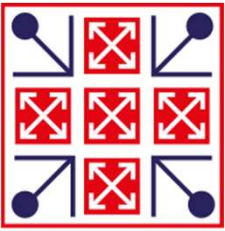

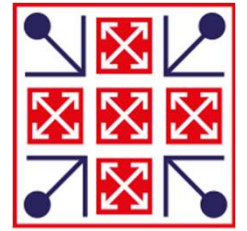

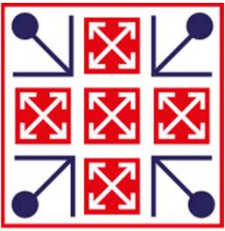
# Profiadau / Experiences in year 7- RJ



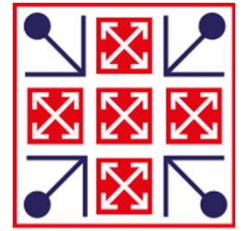
AoLEs organize a range of opportunities across the year such as:
