

## Year 9 French

**Marking:** You will regularly self and peer assess your work in your books, checking for accuracy and quality. Your teacher will also highlight any gaps and weaknesses and you will be expected to redraft your work by the following lesson.

**Assessments:** These will be completed every half term. You will then be given teacher feedback that clearly identifies both the good features and any parts for you to complete to improve your work. In the case of written work these must be completed by the following lesson and should be signed by a teacher as complete.

**Homework:** Homework will be set equivalent to a minimum of 1 hour per week (Pupils will however be asked to do more than this on occasions i.e. when preparing for assessments). Should homework involve a written task it must be clearly labelled under the title **Devoirs**.
