Message from the Headteacher

Welcome to this week's edition of Major News.

I very much hope that you and your families are enjoying this wonderfully warm weather. May I please take the opportunity to remind you of our uniform expectations during the warmer months:

- Please be reminded that leggings are not an acceptable alternative to tailored trousers. If pupils present to school wearing leggings as trousers they will not be permitted into lessons. Instead, they will be provided with appropriate clothing from our uniform store and if appropriate stock is not available then parents/carers will be called and asked to bring appropriate uniform to school.
- Black tailored shorts are permitted but sports shorts are not and pupils will not be allowed into lessons
 wearing these either. If they present to school wearing these then parents/carers will be contacted and
 asked to bring appropriate uniform to school.
- All pupils are expected to wear full school uniform to all public examinations.
- Short sleeved white shirts are of course acceptable but pupils are still expected to wear their school tie.
- All black footwear, worn with socks, is acceptable. Sandals and crocs are not permitted.

Pupils have been reminded of these expectations by classroom teachers today, but I would very much appreciate it if this message could also be reiterated at home over the weekend. We certainly have no desire to interrupt parents and carers during the busy working day, but it is most important that we adopt a consistent approach to uniform and enforce the rules in an equitable manner. As we have articulated to our pupils today, our school uniform identifies our pupils as members of the Llantwit School community and I would encourage them to wear it with pride.

As ever, many thanks for your continued support and I wish you all an enjoyable weekend in this glorious sunshine.

Contacting School

Please be reminded that we operate an appointments only system for meeting with parents/carers and if you present at school requesting an immediate appointment we will not be able to accommodate you.

Forgotten Items

We can no longer accept the delivery of forgotten items such as PE kit, books, lunch boxes etc. during the school day. Please ensure your child arrives at school with the equipment needed for the day. In the exceptional case that you do need to bring an item into school for your child, you will be asked to leave it on the desk in the main entrance. This is to reduce traffic on to the school site and ensure student safety during lesson transitions.

Medication

Please note we **do not** stock medication of any kind in school, including paracetamol, and we are not allowed to dispense medication without parental consent. If your child receives prescribed medication a medical form, available from main Reception to be collected by your son/daughter, will be required to be completed and returned to Reception. Should your child need medication throughout the school day please ensure they bring just what is needed for the day to school with them.
