#### Welsh Baccalaureate Department

### Exam Results

Congratulations to Year 10 and Year 13 pupils! The Welsh Baccalaureate department have been busy this week sharing excellent WJEC results with Year 10 and Year 13 pupils.

Year 10 pupils have received their first set of results from the WJEC (their Community Challenge results) which will contribute up to 25% towards their final GCSE grade. Year 13 pupils have received the results of 3 pieces of work (their Community, Global and Enterprise & Employability challenges) This will contribute to 50% of their final A level grade. We have spent the week explaining to all students the impact that these results will have on their final grade, and analysing and providing feedback on further marks / grades needed to achieve a variety of final GCSE and A level grades. ### Advance Notice

All Year 10 students are currently studying for the Global Challenge element of their Welsh Baccalaureate GCSE. The topic the pupils are studying is marine litter and they have already conducted analysis of a variety of sources of information on this topic. As part of the qualification pupils are allocated 5 hours to create a pack which raises awareness of marine litter, the issues and solutions they have read about in their sources of information booklet. The pupils are allocated a day (5 hours) where this is to be completed. This must be a substantial piece of work which is creative and innovative. In the past we have seen artwork, quizzes, board games, models and the like created over the 5 hours. We have asked pupils to start thinking about what they would like to create on their allocated day. Whilst the department will supply materials to support this element of the qualification, we have suggested that pupils may want to start collecting some items from their household recycling which they may want to use to highlight the issue of plastic in the oceans, such as yoghurt pots, milk bottle tops etc. **As usual, all pupils will be expected to be in school uniform and plastic aprons will be available**. <u>The Global Challenge is worth 25% of the final GCSE grade</u>. This is a supervised task which must be completed in order to pass the qualification.

If students are unsure which class they are in, they will need to see their Welsh Baccalaureate teacher in advance of the days.

The sun was shining for another fantastic extracurricular football session. Well-being Leader, Oliver Poole, for leading the session.





#### **Contacting School**

Please be reminded that we operate an appointments only system for meeting with parents/carers and if you present at school requesting an immediate appointment we will not be able to accommodate you.

#### Forgotten Items

We can no longer accept the delivery of forgotten items such as PE kit, books, lunch boxes etc. during the school day. Please ensure your child arrives at school with the equipment needed for the day. In the exceptional case that you do need to bring an item into school for your child, you will be asked to leave it on the desk in the main entrance. This is to reduce traffic on to the school site and ensure student safety during lesson transitions.

#### Medication

Please note we **do not** stock medication of any kind in school, including paracetamol, and we are not allowed to dispense medication without parental consent. If your child receives prescribed medication a medical form, available from main Reception to be collected by your son/daughter, will be required to be completed and returned to Reception. Should your child need medication throughout the school day please ensure they bring just what is needed for the day to school with them.
