

SCHOOL WEBSITE POLICY

Purpose of the Website

- Llantwit Major School values the contribution values that a website can make to the life and role of the school in a modern society. The School's website has 5 important roles:
- To promote the school;
 - To provide information to prospective parents, teachers, the wider community and the world;
 - To act as a communication channel between the school to parents, pupils and the general public;
- To be part of the provision to support pupils and families in learning and development;
- To raise standards in teaching and learning.

1.1 Website Structure

- 1.2 As a content managed site there are two main sections to the site: -
 - The front end published site, which is available to anyone, anywhere with Internet access to browse.
 - The private back end site, which is available only to authorised members of the school community and the service provider.

Access to the private back end is controlled by username and password.

Green house school websites allows the Site Administrator to develop a site that users can access and add content to the site. User accounts are only created with the approval of the School Business Manager. Users are teachers, pupils, administration staff and parents. User accounts that can add content are limited to school staff and are only created with the approval of the Head Teacher.

An up to date list of current users who have access to add content and their roles is held by the school IT Support team.

10 Access and Approval

- 10.1 The system operates on role-based publishing allowing a site administrator to create new users and manage existing users, and choose whether content editors can publish directly to the internet or to a 'pending approval' area. Content on the school website is controlled by role access. Essentially there are 3 roles: contributors, editors and administrators. All material submitted to the site is initially given a status of 'Pending Review'. Any comments are sent directly to a school email and must be approved by the site administrator/ Business Manager and an additional delegate member of the SLT before publishing.
- 10.2 Contributors are allowed to submit new pages and upload photographs via the admin backend for approval prior to publication. Contributors are also allowed to edit their own content. Contributors are not allowed to promote 'Pending Review' content to 'Published'.

Editors are allowed to submit new pages and upload photographs via the backend for approval prior to publication. Editors are allowed to edit their own content and also contributors' content. Editors are allowed to promote 'Pending Review' content to 'Published'. Editors may also demote 'Published' content to 'Unpublished'.

Administrators have full access to the WordPress environment for the purposes of maintaining the software and the underlying technical environment. This includes tasks such as user administration and software maintenance and upgrade. Administrators will not publish materials to the site unless expressly authorised by the site administrator/ Business Manager and an additional delegate member of the SLT

Administrators will not publish materials to the site unless authorised.

Staff users are allowed limited access to certain pages. These pages will be saved in draft and can be reviewed by the administrators before publishing.

Administrators have full access to the greenhouseschoolwebsites.co.uk software for the purposes of maintaining the website. This includes tasks such as user administration and software maintenance and upgrade.

11 Names, pictures and content

- Where pupils are named, only first names should be given;
- Where a pupil is fully named, no photograph of that pupil should be displayed;
- Where a photograph is used which shows a pupil, no full name is displayed.

By observing these points, the school ensures that visitors to the website cannot link images of pupils to names of pupils. When choosing photographs for the website, the school is mindful of the way pupils may appear in them, and will avoid including images which are in any way inappropriate.

- The school follows a policy of seeking parents' permission before using images of pupils on school publicity and this includes on the website.
- No other private information about pupils is ever published on the website such as surnames or contact details.
- Children will only be shown in photos where they are suitably dressed.
- Personal details of children or staff such as home addresses, telephone numbers, personal e-mail addresses, etc, will not be released via the website.
- Links to external websites will be checked thoroughly before inclusion on the school website. The sites will be checked for the suitability of their content for their intended audience.
- Any text written by pupils will be reviewed before inclusion to ensure that no personal details are accidentally included that could lead to the identification of the pupil e.g. membership of after school clubs.
- All written work will be reviewed to ensure that it is in no way defamatory.
- Written work will be checked to ensure (as far as possible) that no copyright or intellectual property rights are infringed.
- All written material will be checked for its suitability for its intended audience.

12 Privacy

12.1 Adults have the right to refuse permission to publish their image on the site.

12.2 Parents have the right to refuse permission for their child's work and/or image to be published on the site.

Those wishing to exercise this right should express their wishes in writing to the Head Teacher, clearly stating whether they object to work, images, or both being published, to the site. Parents will be notified of this right as part of the school induction pack that all parents/ pupils receive prior to enrolment.

13 Monitoring

13.1 An Editor will check material before it is uploaded or published to ensure that it is suitable and complies with the record of objections held by the Head Teacher and with copyright laws (as far as is possible). Any persons named on a web page can ask for their details to be removed.

New pages will be tested for errors immediately after installation.

The web pages will be regularly reviewed for accuracy and will be updated as required. This review will occur at least annually. It will be the responsibility of an Administrator, school management, staff or authorised agents to ensure this happens.

14.1 At least two people should have the knowledge to maintain and edit the site, and they must pass on their knowledge to a successor at the end of a term of office. Training for new contributors is provided as necessary by the school IT support team.
