# Aims:

- 1.To manage and coordinate the transition of pupils from the feeder primary schools to the secondary school.
- 2.To ensure learning across a continuum which will be achieved through cluster communication and collaborative curriculum design.
- 3.To ensure individual pupil progression as they transition from primary to secondary school.
- 4.To ensure that the learning needs and well-being of each individual pupil is supported as they transition from primary to secondary school.
- 5.To ensure that opportunities exist to review and monitor the impact of the transition plan.
