Llantwit Major School is committed to supporting Fairtrade wherever possible.

Fairtrade is about guaranteeing a better deal for third world producers.

In particular the school will:

- set up and support the Fairtrade Steering Group as part of our Eco-group;
- use Fairtrade products wherever possible:
 - tea, coffee, sugar and biscuits in parents evenings, governors meetings and coffee mornings
 - in Food Technology
 - in Enterprise activities e.g. Enterprise Week, Christmas fete and Victorian fayre
 - in charity events e.g. cake sales

We will also endeavour to raise awareness of Fairtrade in the school by:

- ensuring learning about Fairtrade happens for at least two year groups in a range of lessons and in whole school activities including assemblies;
- promoting Fairtrade at least once a term in school and at least once a year in the wider community, particularly during Fairtrade Fortnight;
- displaying information about Fairtrade and Fairtrade events on notice boards.
