Dear Parent/Guardian

Following my previous letters on the change of school uniform, please find below the final details.

As you are aware, the School has followed a process of consultation with parents and pupils, Student Council and Governors in order to review the school uniform. The Governors have agreed that from September 2017 there will be a new school uniform for Key Stages 3 and 4 (i.e. Years 7-11). The new uniform will be compulsory for new Year 7 pupils, but following Welsh Assembly guidance, there will be a year for pupils who are already in the school to move across to the new uniform, should that time be required.

There will be no change in uniform for the 6th Form.

A summary of changes is outlined below:

School Uniform Key Stages 3&4

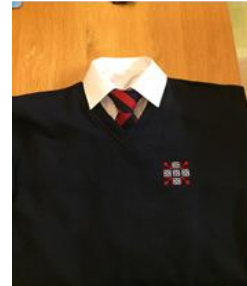
Compulsory for Year 7 from September 2017; compulsory for Years 8-11 from September 2018.

Overview of changes:

Uniform will remain the same apart from:

- a white shirt with red and blue tie (photo opposite);
- the new school logo will appear on the V neck jumper.

Ties will be available in both clip tie and traditional tie versions.



P E Kit

Compulsory for Year 7 from September 2017; compulsory for Years 8-11 from September 2018

Overview of changes.

PE kit will remain the same apart from:

- a compulsory long sleeved top for girls;
- compulsory navy leggings for girls;
- compulsory navy shorts for boys;
- no colour restriction on swimwear.

Please see attached a full list of uniform and PE kit.

A cost list from a local supplier is attached for information. New uniform items will be sold following the school finishing for the summer break (after 19 July 2017).

There will be a display of the new uniform in Llantwit Major Sports shop from 15 May 2017.
