Year 6 parents/guardians – final information letter

Dear parent/guardian

As we move towards the school summer holidays I am writing with some final information for you about your child's transition to Comprehensive School.

Uniform

Llantwit Major Sports shop advise that they may become very busy as the summer holiday progresses due to restrictions on shop numbers etc. They therefore kindly request that you visit early in the holidays to purchase items for your child.

September start date/Year 6 into Year 7

Your child will start school on 3 September at 8.30am. Please note that we operate a staggered start so this will not be the same for other year groups. School ends at 3pm. Your child will then attend school every day.

They should aim to arrive in school by 8.25am. They will meet their Form Tutor in the school yard when the bell sounds. It is therefore useful if they know their form class eg 7KD or 7MJD. If they do not know this they should ask their Primary school teacher or you can email the school for the attention of Mrs Marshallsay.

Pupils should attend in full school uniform with a bag containing their equipment (see previous letter on website – Year 6 transition section on front page.) They will not need PE kit on the first day in school.

Pupils should bring a packed lunch and filled water bottle or money to buy food from the canteen.
